Dear Friends,

Thank you for making 2018 another remarkable year for The Clemson Free Clinic. Our dedicated staff and volunteers have done an outstanding job of providing continuing quality healthcare to our patients. Our goal is to provide continuity of care, education, and pharmaceuticals to our patients. This ensures patients have the resources and knowledge to manage their chronic health conditions and improve overall health status.

The Clemson Free Clinic provides a wide range of services for the medically underserved. Our free clinic focuses on providing quality free primary healthcare and pharmaceuticals. Examples of additional services we are able to provide include laboratory and imaging (off-site), women’s healthcare, immunizations, diabetic self-management education and specialty referral. Our newest service is Produce RX, a pilot program, providing fresh fruits and vegetables to diabetic patients to demonstrate the effects of healthy eating on managing their chronic disease. This program is an outgrowth of partnering with a Leadership Clemson class. Preliminary results are showing improvements.

25% of prescription drugs don’t get filled due to cost. Unfortunately this is how most of our patients come to need services. They end up sicker than they need to be because they can’t afford their medicines. Often times they end up in the emergency room. We are thankful to be able to provide medications for our patients at no cost to them. Every \$1 donated to a South Carolina Free Clinic provides a minimum of \$5 worth of healthcare services. 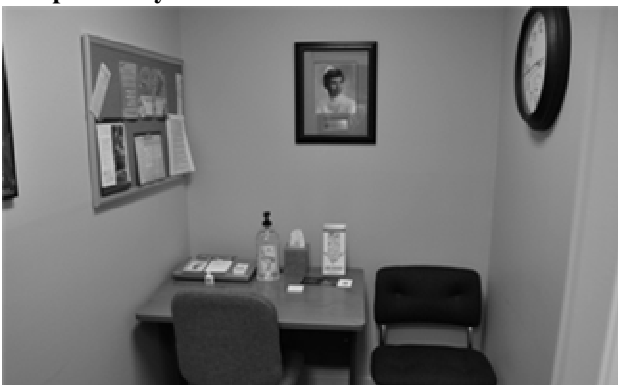

In 2018 there were 315 patient/provider visits, 45 patients referred for specialty care, 21 dental referrals, 52 nutritionist visits, and 18 patients enrolled in Prescription Assistance Programs for medications too expensive to stock in our pharmacy.
