The Clemson Free Clinic is fortunate to have great student volunteers. Three of our current ones leave for medical school this fall. We want our CFC donors to know how lucky the clinic is to attract the best and brightest.

Roann Abdeladl is from Greenville, SC. She graduated December of 2021 with a degree in Health Sciences from Clemson where she was recruited as National Scholar and became a finalist for the Truman Scholarship in her senior year. Because of her life experiences, Roann developed an interest in social determinants of well-being especially for those who lack access to the resources to improve their lives. She sees that first hand at CFC.

She has been accepted by five medical schools so far. Her first choice is Loyola University because of its service-oriented and community-based medical program. This would fit well with her interests in either Primary Care or Internal Medicine. She wants to connect with her patients and follow their progress as their point of contact to the medical system. Her goal is to provide culturally competent care to all.

Christopher (Chris) Ply is from Charleston, SC. He will graduate from Clemson in May 2022 with a degree in Microbiology. Chris came to Clemson because of its strong STEM program. In-state tuition plus the Palmetto Scholars Program made CU an affordable option. Several family members are medical professionals which stimulated his interest. At CU, Chris became an EMT, demonstrating the positive effects he could have as a medical care professional.

He has been accepted to four schools including his top choice, Georgetown University. His interest is in surgery either Ear, Nose, and Throat or plastic with an emphasis on repairing trauma/birth defects. Chris plans to offer services to the underserved as part of his practice.

Samantha (Sammi) Spence from St. Louis, Missouri. She graduates in May 2022 with a degree in Biological Sciences and minors in Spanish and Psychology. Sammi grew up in the medical field. Her dad is a physician and her mom is a nurse manager. Hearing them talk about their days and watching them interact with patients helped her choose her career path.

She has been accepted to four schools to date. Her top choices are: St. Louis University, University of Missouri and Virginia Commonwealth University. She has not yet narrowed down a specialty, but surgery appeals to her love for hands-on, procedural medicine. Like the others, Sammi's experience at CFC has given her insight to the needs of underserved populations. She wants to work with uninsured, low-income people in her community wherever that might be.
